

Praying For Believers In Your Neighborhood

Acts 17:26

"And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place."

We are blessed to be dwelling in the homes and neighborhoods in which God has placed us. We need to view our neighborhoods as one of our places of mission. We need to have a love for those that God has placed around us, especially for those that are part of God's family. (John 13:34-35)

Gather with other believers in your neighborhood. If there is not a gathering already happening in your area, consider opening your home and inviting some believing neighbors over. You can also check the church website for a gathering closest to your home.

- Discuss personal prayer requests with each other.
- Pray for the believers in the area that were not able to join you.
- Take a prayer walk throughout the neighborhood praying for believers that you have not yet met.

Read through Philippians 1:1-11

- Give thanks for the partnership of believers in your neighborhood.
- Give thanks that you partake in a common mission, that is to further the Gospel.
- Pray that God would give you that same passion that Paul had for fellow believers.
- Pray that love may abound more and more in the hearts of the believers in your area.
- Pray for wisdom and discernment both for yourself and the believers around you.
- Pray for fruit in the lives of the believers in your area.

Throughout your day

- Pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18). Pray for fellow believers throughout your day whether you are at work, school, shopping, the park or anywhere else you may find yourself. Take time throughout your day to give thanks and pray.
